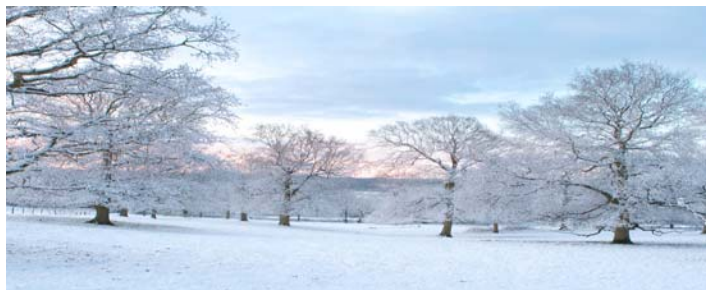

**Website and payment options!**

I would like to encourage all our customers to visit our website.

([www.nclwd.org](http://www.nclwd.org)) There you can find helpful information about the District. One of the most helpful pieces of the website is the on-line payment option to pay your bill. Simply click on the "Pay My Bill" tab, click "online credit card payment", then "Make a Payment. You will then enter the amount you would like to pay and continue. You will need your account number. If you would like to pay on line and do not have your account number, please call the office and I can get that for you. **We will not accept payments over the phone.**

I would also encourage you to take advantage of our ACH payment option. This option automatically withdraws your amount due from your bank once per quarter. Fill out the ACH form available on the website, and send that to the District along with a voided check. It's that simple! Please include your phone number so that we can inform you of when the first payment will be withdrawn.

**2014 Water Meter Testing and Inspection**

**I will be inspecting all meter pits and testing the operation of all meters in 2014. I will be doing this in the spring and early summer. Please keep in mind that some of your meters are behind your homes. So don't be alarmed if you see a guy walking around in your yard. :-)** Look for the guy in the safety vest! I will also ask for your help. Over time, meter pits get "lost" due to debris and vegetation growth. So, if you know where your meter pit is, please remove any debris, cut back shrubs or vegetation, and mark it. That will make my task easier. The District needs access to your meter pit at all times. Please keep it clear. Thank You!

**Billing Cycle**

Water utilities are billed quarterly -- and are due on February 15, May 15, August 15 and November 15 of each year. The District will adhere to policy and disconnect your water service if payment is not received by the shut-off date. Call the office if you have questions.
